Admission Requirements - **Meeting requirements does not guarantee acceptance.*

- Application for admission and acceptance to Volunteer State Community College is required prior to application to the nursing program. Student must be in good academic standing with the college. Must be 18 years of age by program start date.
- Prerequisite courses for the associate of applied science degree in nursing program must be completed by the end of the spring semester before the semester in which you are applying for, with a "C" or better and minimum prerequisite GPA of 2.9.
- Complete the TEAS test prior to the application deadline. A minimum of proficient must be earned.
- Complete an official application to the A.A.S. in nursing program.
 - o Applications become available December 1st.
 - o Applications are due April 1st for Gallatin and Livingston campuses and July 1st for the Springfield campus. Applications will not be accepted after the deadline. They must be submitted online. See application for LPN to RN deadlines.
- In some instances, an interview may be required.
